The Corporations and Health Project was launched in 2004 at Hunter College, City University of New York to analyze the impact of corporate practices such as advertising, product design, retailing and pricing on health and to identify effective strategies for reducing harmful corporate practices.

The project focuses on six industries that have a significant effect on public health: automobile, food and beverages, alcohol, pharmaceutical, firearms and tobacco.
